

**THE KENYA INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS ACT, 1998
LICENSE TO ESTABLISH RADIOCOMMUNICATION STATIONS**

1. The Licensee shall observe the current provisions of the International Telecommunication convention / Constitution, and the Radio Regulations or those of any subsequent International Telecommunication Convention and Regulations which may replace them so far as they are applicable to the class of station named in this Licence. The Licensee shall also be subject to the Kenya Information and Communications Act, 1998, the Communications Regulations promulgated pursuant thereto, and to the orders and decisions of the Authority.
2. The transmitters shall be operated under an annual Licence which must be kept in force at all times by renewing on or before the anniversary of the expiry date in accordance with the Communications Regulations and Section 36 of the Kenya Information and Communications Act, 1998.
3. If any message is received which the licensee is not entitled to receive under the terms of this licence, the Licensee shall not make known or allow to be made known its contents, its origin or destination, its existence or the fact of its receipt to any person (other than a duly authorised officer of the Authority or a competent legal tribunal) and shall not reproduce in writing, copy or make use of such messages or allow the same to be reproduced in writing, copied or made use of.
4. The equipment used on the station shall be type approved by the Authority, and shall not operate on any frequencies other than those authorised.
5. The station shall be operated only by persons duly authorised by the Licensee, for the purposes laid down in this Licence.
6. A log book shall be kept showing each day's operation and shall include, in addition to a complete record of the communications made by the station, the signature of each operator at the time he/she assumes or relinquishes a watch.
7. The station shall be subject to approval of the Authority and together with this licence shall be open to inspection at all reasonable times by duly authorised officers of the Authority.
8. This licence is subject to withdrawal or modification at any time by specific notice in writing sent to Licensee. Any breach of the conditions of this Licence, the provisions of the Act, or the Communications Regulations will render this licence liable to suspension or cancellation.
9. This frequency assignment shall not be loaded with any value-added service whatsoever without prior authorisation by the Authority.
10. If the Licensee is authorised to provide a communication service utilising the radio stations licensed pursuant hereto under a telecommunication or other licence issued by the Authority, all of the terms and conditions of the said Licence are hereby fully incorporated into and made part of this RADIO LICENCE as if they were fully stated herein.
11. On the occurrence of any public emergency or in the interest of public safety or tranquility, the Cabinet Secretary responsible for internal security within the state, may by order in writing, direct:
 - a) any authorised employee of the Authority to take temporary possession of any radiocommunication station within the state and the apparatus which may be installed or used therein; and
 - b) that any communication or class of communication shall or shall not be emitted from such station or apparatus.
