- This licence shall be valid for a period **THREE (3) YEARS** subject to the payment of appropriate annual fee and may be renewed subject to such terms and conditions as may be specified by the Authority.
- 2. This licence is not transferable.
- 3. The Licensee shall pay to the Authority Annual fee in in Tanzanian Shillings two million three hundred thousand (TZS 2,300,000) only.
- 4. Three months prior to expiry of the licence period, the Licensee shall apply to the Authority for renewal of the licence.
- 5. Annual licence fee delayed for more than thirty (30) days shall be charged interest of fifteen percent (15%) of the outstanding fee for each month of delay.
- 6. The Authority shall not be responsible for any claims or proceedings arising from any breach or failings on the part of the Licensee.
- 7. The Licensee shall comply with the provisions of the Acts and other laws of the United Republic of Tanzania.
